

RE: California Proposition 65 compliance

To whom it may concern:

In accordance with the State of California's Proposition 65 regulation that requires a company to notify California residents of products that contain significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, Cummins is sending this letter to provide confirmation of the label or on-screen notification to the portable pump operator based on California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment's "Safe Harbor" Warning Requirements.


Pursuant to CCR. Tit. 27, § 25607.14 (Diesel Engine Exposure Warnings), manufacturers of vehicles for Off-Highway use, powered by a diesel engine, must provide a warning:

• "On a label permanently attached to the product in a location that is easily visible to the operator of the vehicle, engine or other equipment when it is being operated,

OR

If other warnings or operating instructions are provided in an on-screen display."

Cummins chose to meet this requirement with the label notification for those portable pumps manufactured by Cummins for sale in the State of California.



Cummins acknowledges and agrees to ensure compliance with CCR. Tit. 27, § 25607.14 and that failure to have such procedures in place may result in the cessation of supply of Cummins portable pumps.
